
Report February 2023 Norway


Friday 17th February:

Monday 20th February:


Today, Kristin's mother had a lot of meetings for work so we just rested and read.

with the car to cross to the other side. After that, we walked and visited the area. In the evening, Maud and Thea ate dinner with us and we played some games.


